An **Extinction Burst** is a temporary, intense increase of a behavior that occurs when the reinforcement for that behavior is removed. Extinction bursts happens when a behavior that used to get attention or reinforcement suddenly stops working — so the child temporarily increases that behavior to try to get the old result back. It's a normal part of behavior change!

The increase in behavior doesn't mean the plan isn't working — it's often a sign that **it is** working. The child is testing whether the same behavior will still get the same response.

Extinction bursts usually don't last long if everyone stays consistent. Once the child realizes the behavior no longer works, the behavior will start to decrease.

Spontaneous Recovery is the reappearance or increase of a behavior that was already extinct. This can happen after the behavior has stopped for a while, but consistency will help it fade again.
